# July 13-20

The team would like to thank everyone who attended the Don Rowland Pancakes for Missions and Silent Auction in May. A little over \$3,000 was raised for the trip.

After arriving in Guatemala City, the team will travel to Peurto Barrios where they will visit some of the remote villages to hold medical and dental clinics. They may also deliver and set up water filters to some of the homes and do some light construction. Activities will also be planned to do with the children in the villages.
