Over the past two weeks I have noticed Bibles popping up throughout my classroom. Bibles that students are reading during independent reading time. That's right...5th grade students are bringing their Bibles into a public school classroom.



I often hear "God isn't allowed in public schools." However, I feel that isn't the case. Even though teachers may not be allowed to "preach" that does not mean that they can't show the love of God by their actions.

Four years ago, on a Monday, I had a student tell me that he wanted what I had. At the time I was writing with a minion pencil and offered it to the child (let's be honest, it was a chewed on pencil, that wasn't even mine to begin with because...well..students had used all of mine). He turned it down and said, "Nah, that's not it." I quickly moved on to all of the other tasks of the classroom that day and didn't think anything else about it. Thursday rolls around and the same student comes up to me and says, "Ms. Smith, I'm getting what you have. I went to church last night." I told him I was so excited for him and asked him what he liked most about it. He responded "We got snack, I'm learning how to use a Bible and there is a girl there I like." We continued on with our week. The following Monday rolls back around and here I am sitting on the carpet with all of my students, while they shared something great that happened to them over the weekend. We have made it around to the friend that has been giving me bits and pieces of what he wanted the week prior. The student then speaks and says, "Ms. Smith!!! I FINALLY have what you have!" Me being so confused says, "What is that?" The student answered with, "I went to church again last night and I asked Jesus to be in my heart! Now I have what you have!"

THAT. Right then and there, I knew B115 is where I was supposed to be. It was like everything in my room suddenly stopped. It was like the world had stopped. This student had been preparing me for something that I had no idea I had anything to do with! I had never professed my faith to my class of 10 year olds. When they asked about my faith, I would share with them that I was a Christian but never thought to force my beliefs on them.

This is just proof that actions speak louder than words. Today as I took this picture, I could not help but to go back to that blue carpet and remember what happened my 1st year teaching. I believe that God has never, can never and will never be removed from a classroom. Each day we all enter a mission field. Are your actions worth watching?
