Week 1 – Who do we call God?

Come to class prepared:

1. Read the handout “God’s Holiness and your worship” (*Attached*)
2. Select 1 or 2 scriptures that describe the character of God
3. Consider:
  - a. When you think of God as Holy, what comes to mind?
  - b. What makes God Holy?

2. Consider:

  - c. In vs. 5, why does Isaiah feel lost? *undone or ruined*
  - d. What makes us unholy?

Come to class prepared:

1. Read Leviticus 11:44; Rom 12:1-2
2. Consider:
  - a. Is there a connection between our understanding of the “*Holiness of God*” and our response to worshipping or serving?

Week 4 – We worship a Holy God

Come to class prepared:

1. Read Psalms 65,66,68, 99, 100
  - a. Consider: Discuss 2 or 3 attributes of God described in these psalms that make him worthy of our worship.
2. Read Psalms 95,96,115
  - a. Consider: Discuss How do these Psalms speak to the “*How & Why*” we are to worship.
3. Read Psalms 67 & 101
  - a. Consider: In Psalm 67 vs 1
    - i. What are we asking for?
    - ii. Can you think of a time when man saw the face of God?  
*Discuss*
    - iii. From this Psalm can we connection between reflecting the holiness of God and our lives? *Discuss*
  - b. Consider: Psalm 101
    - i. In what ways does this Psalm speak to our *Covenant* with the LORD?
      1. Our commitment to the covenant is framed by 5 “*I Will*” statements.
    - ii. In vs. 8 consider the 2 parts of this verse. Each has a separate action. *Discuss what they are and how we should respond to these today?*
