For Father's Day my family took me to a barbecue restaurant that I like near Charlotte. We have eaten there several times, and every time we have eaten at this restaurant, I have enjoyed the food. While we waited for our drinks and appetizer to come, I noticed that Emma's iPhone case was cracked and breaking. So, being a good parent, I asked her about this and wondered what she was going to do about it?

She told me that she was worried about the safety of her phone if she dropped it but wasn't doing anything to resolve the issue. I resisted the urge to chastise her for buying something of poor quality, and instead, I gave her my case to solve the problem. It was a case that I felt that I didn't need anyway. Honestly, I was looking for an excuse to trade-up to something different myself. But by doing so, I created a new problem. Now I had to deal with her broken case myself, and it created a source of irritation for me.

For the week of VBS, and on into half of this week, I have fought her phone case. It 'sticks' to the inside of my pocket and does not come out neatly. It turns my pocket inside out every time that I take it out and is hard to put away. I can see why she did not like the case.

Finally last night Emma returned my case to me. She bought a new one that was similar to mine in its durability. Relieved I snapped my case back into place and I returned to my book thinking nothing more about the whole incident. But now every time I pick up my iPhone, I notice the returned case and I smile. So here is the point of this unique and very personal story for you:

There are times in our faith that we do not notice the thing that is right before us until it is absent. It was there and now it is not. We may have forgotten how important it was to us but the absence of it nags at our heart. At times this can be as small as a cell phone case that we loaned to someone or as simple as a blessing from God that we never noticed in the first place. Yet it was present the whole time if we were observant.

Perhaps the task of faith, a task that God wonders if we will continue to practice this summer, is to take the time and notice what is right before us. Sure, there are big blessings that God places in our lives, but there are also little things present too. Can we notice them both? For both are gifts from God.
